**Please Note:**

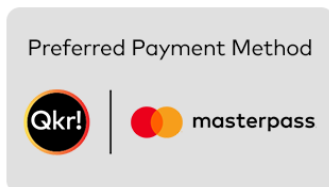
- **It is a requirement that students have a personal computing device for learning. Please see the separate form with available options**
