Why not think about 'building your own?'

Your idea must be able to fit into the Aspire guidelines: it has to be something difficult, above and beyond what you would do in class. Remember Aspire is for students who want to surprise their teachers, their parents, their friends, but most of all themselves with the awesome work they are capable of.

Think about the way in which you could present your idea: will it be a movie, a book, a physical presentation?

Think about what you will include in your presentation:-

- Why you chose your topic/theme.
- A brief overview of any inspiration materials you used
- A discussion about the challenges and positives you encountered in your exploration of your idea.
- A conclusion about what you learnt on your journey and how it has inspired you.

Remember before you begin this challenge you need to see one of the staff members mentioned above to make sure that your idea is an Aspire challenge.
